



Chalet Annelies



Situated in Verbier in Switzerland, *Chalet Annelies*, designed by Kamini Ezralow, was torn down and completely rebuilt to the specifications of the client. Using bespoke furniture throughout, Kamini ensured that a beautiful space was created. Old wood was used on all the floors except in the kitchen and bathrooms where Luzerne stone was used, creating a warm, cosy atmosphere. The chalet benefits from stunning views of the surrounding area as well as a garage, a sauna and a wine cellar.

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Undoubtedly the heart of the property, the open plan living and dining areas are located on the top floor of the chalet which has panoramic views of the surrounding mountains and the resort. There is a large open fireplace, wrap around balconies with outdoor dining space and a well-equipped kitchen.

The entrance on the lower floor (opposite right) might be at the bottom of the chalet but it certainly doesn't rank that way. The entire floor champions luxury and houses the entertainment area with cinema room, private bar and beautiful spa with rock bath, sauna and hammam.









Stairs lead to the middle floor containing three bedrooms, all with access to the surrounding terraces or balconies.

On the lower floor, a private spa complete with rock bath, sauna and hammam (steam room).

The well equipped kitchen opens onto this open-plan living area situated on the top floor.



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
