BUBBLE GLOW

Designer Stephanie Coutas' gorgeous lighting creation for atelier Alain Elouze, named Bolero, is a masterclass in manipulating alabaster, Coutas' preferred material. Cut completely by hand, the alabaster balls weighing between 5kg and 50kg hang from a metallic structure in groups of five or six. Thanks to the translucent nature of the material, each emits a soft glow produced by a bulb within, creating the perfect juxtaposition between the design's hard and soft nature. stephaniecoutas.com

MIST INTERPRETED

Royal Selangor has molded its pewter know-how with the talent of award-winning local designer Nathan Yong of Grafunkt to produce Vapour, a line of tableware that incorporates walnut wood, Yulakas marble and resin. Inspired by the hydrologic cycle, or the transformation of water to vapour, the surfaces of the collection of tea caddies, bowls and tumblers are textured with dissipating vertical lines, resulting in a graphic but sleek design.
